
Supports a wide range of benefits

Acción Andina was founded in 2019 by Global Forest Generation and Peruvian NGO Asociación Ecosistemas Andinas (ECOAN). Since then, Acción Andina has grown from working with a few hundred families in Peru, to a movement which includes 30,000 families from local Indigenous communities all across the Andes – all coming together to plant species of *Polylepis* and protect and restore Andean ecosystems.

It is an award-winning initiative, working with local communities on holistic ecosystem restoration – winning an Earthshot Prize 2023 and being recognised as one of seven UN World Restoration Flagships in 2024.

Trees for the Future runs multi-year programmes with local farmers to help restore degraded farmland with an innovative 'Forest Garden' approach.

By the end of the programme, farmers have an established and protected Forest Garden on their own land, which they can use to support their families and generate sustainable income. All the while, the diverse trees planted in the Forest Gardens provide ecosystem services, like stabilising the degraded soil. This fantastic initiative was announced as one of the seven UN World Restoration Flagships in 2024.
